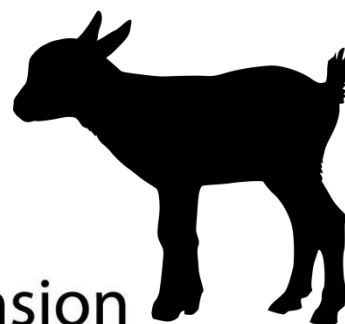

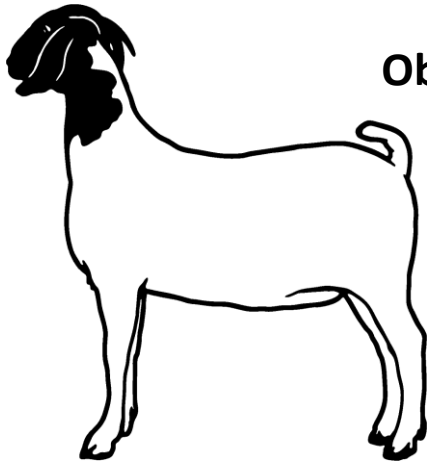

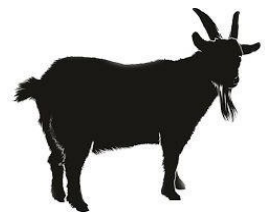
### Objectives of a 4-H Cloverbud Goat Project:

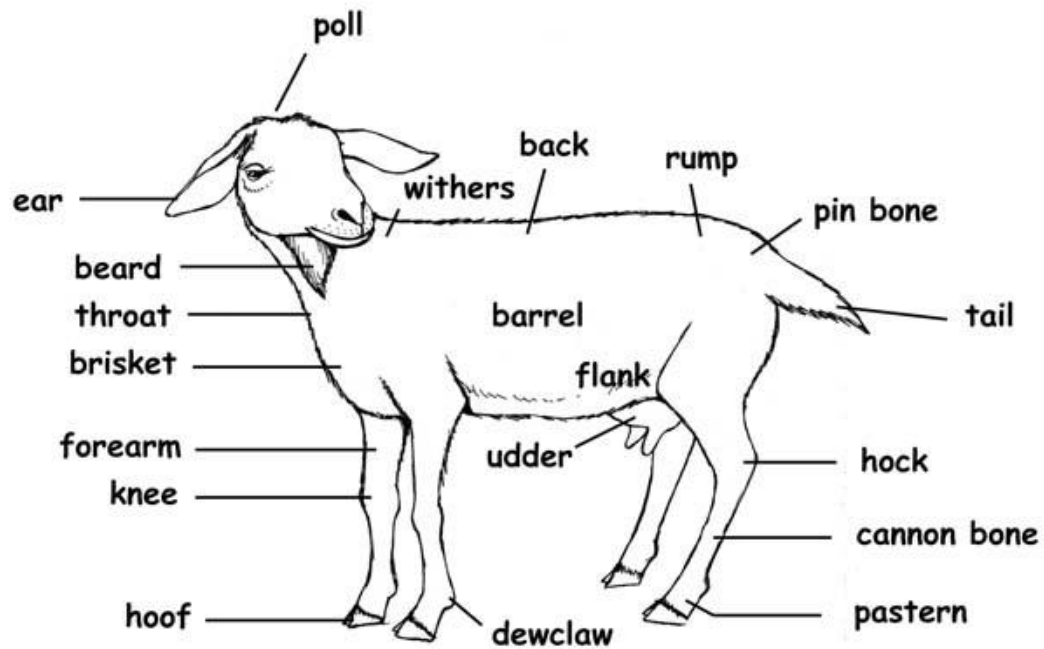

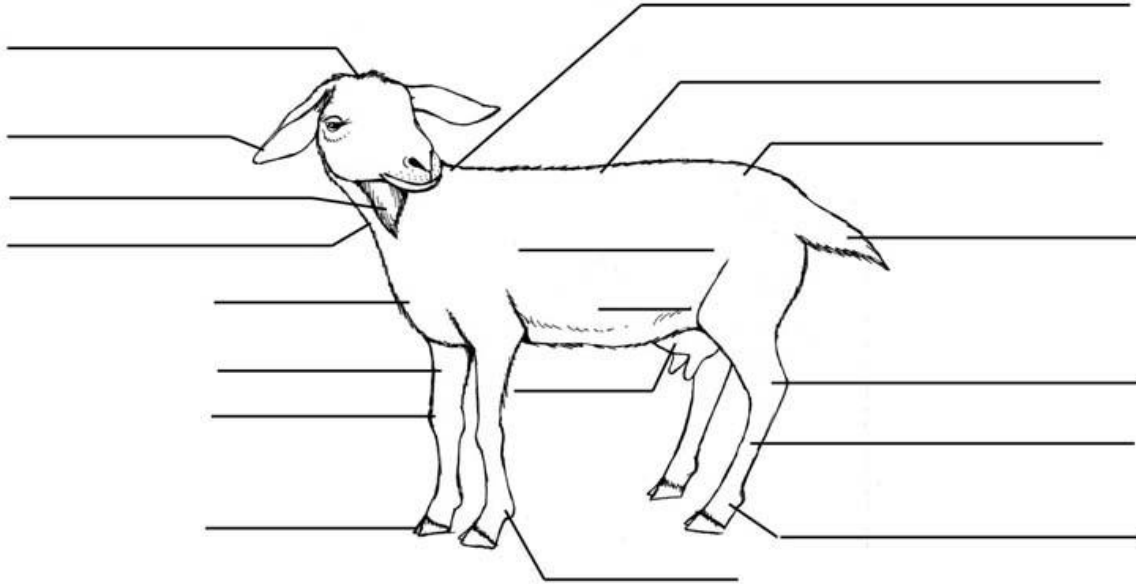


**The Goat**  
*Capra aegagrus hircus*



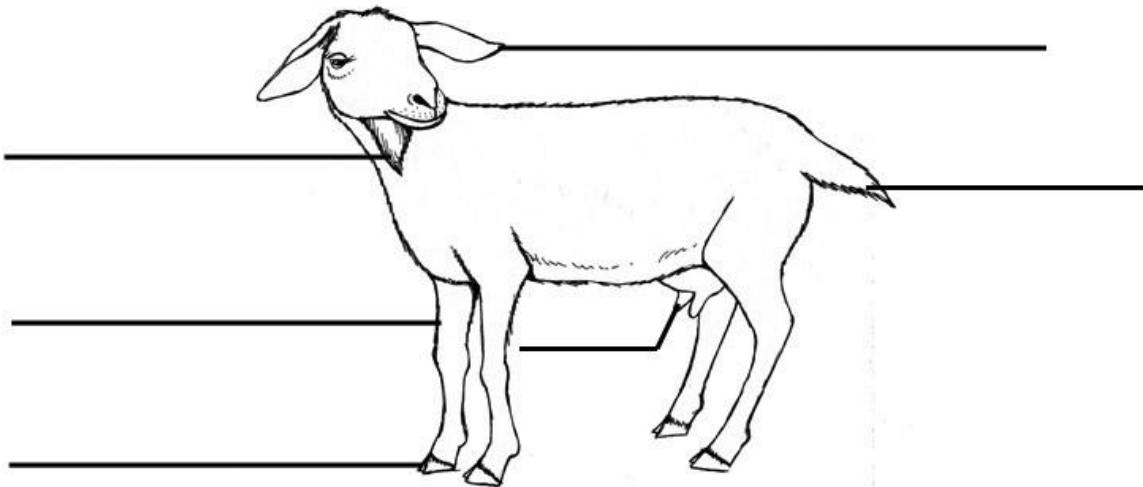
