#### f. Laurie Ashley – Buyers Lunch

- Presentation to see where the funds go to and why.
  - See attached Slides from presentation
  - ❖ Questions asked during the presentation
    - Why stay with Ebels?
      - They have provided the most for the price and everyone always enjoys their food
    - Why have chicken and not pulled pork?
      - Most people can't have pork. Or they didn't like it when we have done it in the past.
    - The lunch didn't hit or exceed the last budget, why the increase?
      - The contract value of just the catering alone is more than what is budgeted now, it's not a guarantee to get everything else donated. Donations are collected until about July, some take that long to get approved.
    - What about the Johnson Foundation donation?
      - We don't know if we get that yet they typically The foundation doesn't know until around June-July.
    - Maybe we shouldn't provide lunch to the kids?
      - We have for decades. We encourage kids to eat with the buyers.
- The membership asked that if more money is needed in the budget then it needs to be brought before the membership at that time.

## **12.New Business**

### Additions to the Agenda

- a. Kelly Stockfisch: Large Beef registration vs. When kids receive checks
  - We should look at when the registration is and when kids receive their checks. Kids won't have time to purchase their next year's project if they don't receive their checks sooner.
  - The council board will discuss the possibility of cutting checks early.
  - Haven Bouwens brought up that they took data from the record books this

past year and all but about 3 youth had their next year's project in their possession before the new possession date that's being discussed for 2026 (November 1st).

- Haven also said this change in possession date is to help have a better start to a project and they can get a weight in the weigh house at the Fairgrounds before winter.
- Raven Butler brought up concerns of projects she has missed purchasing in the past because of the October dispersal of checks.

b. Hannah Gaither and her position with the Teen Rep's

- This position came about because MSU staff was the one to take on organizing and meeting with the Teen Reps to organize events. With no MSU extension coordinator in GT county or Leelanau and only three board members with no applicants by the deadline. Hannah asked if she could help with the Teen Reps.

- It was decided to add as a committee at this time.

- Calves are starting to hit the ground so make sure you are calling breeders to find a calf. There is a list of beef cattle farms on the Jr. Beef page of the website.
- Possession date for Jr. Beef is May 15 th .

- Reminder for market calves there is a minimum weight of 300 and a Maximum weight of 700

#### Rabbit/Cavy – Laire Ashley filling in for Lisa Ralph

- Rabbits for single roasters must be born after February 6th 2025.
- Roaster Projects or any meat pen project must be purebred. No mixes will be accepted for these projects.
- Regular Showmanship Rabbits may be mixed, however if they are mixed they will not be able to enter in a breed class which is judged on Monday of fair. All market rabbit breeds that would be accepted would be; Silver fox, New Zealand, and Californian. A standard Rex will not be accepted for a meat pen.

- Trim Toes.
  - Give your monthly Meningeal worm shot.
- Fresh/ open water is available.
- Body score, make sure they are getting what they need & not more than they need.
- Registration is open for the 2025 education expo on February 23rd. ● Registration is open for the llama and alpaca program which is due by May 5th.
- If you received a “give away prize” make sure to send your thank you note to your sponsor.
- Start gently reminding your show animal that you’ll be working with them again. Touch, halter and release them, spend a little more time in the barn around them.

#### Goat – Robin Gildner

- Registration due next meeting, March 3rd.
- Possession date is May 1st.
- Projects must be born after Nov. 1st 2024, ideally you are looking for a December or January born kid so that they are not over conditioned or past their prime come fair time.
  - If you’re having trouble finding a project, please reach out to me and I can help you locate one.
- Minimum weight is still 65 pounds.
  - You can tag a backup market project for a \$10 fee, due at tagging.
  - Make sure your project has an official USDA scrapie tag in its ear or tattooed with the full tag number. Registration tattoos are accepted with a copy of the pedigree. With either option when the tag is not physically in the goats ear you will need to provide the scrapie tag with the health paperwork at check in the first day of fair.
- Education expo this year at the GT Resort February 23rd. We have a “Working Goat” education session from 11-Noon. Pack and draft goats will both be covered in this session. If you have any ideas for things you want to learn more about, please let me know.
- We have a tentative show time change for our shows on Tuesday. We previously started at 1pm, we are looking to swap with lambs and start at 9am. We just need to verify with judges before we can 100% confirm. If you have any on this please don’t hesitate to reach out.

- ▶ Dawn's Fresh Catering - provides main dish/meat, side dish, and veggie burgers, staff to cook the food, license to cover the meat/side dish liability, equipment to cook and keep food to appropriate temperature
- ▶ Food license from MDARD to cover the food safety of the donated food items (\$73 in 2024)
- ▶ Ice - must have to cool pop and keep pies cool (\$50-\$80)
- ▶ Cake Products from Costco (under \$150 in 2024)
- ▶ Miscellaneous food service supplies to cover what is not donated. Usually under \$100. (foam trays, mustard, table coverings, buns for veggie burgers, food thermometers, wet naps, food pools for pie serving)
