We would like to invite you to the 4-H Livestock Auction on Thursday, August 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022 during the Northwestern Michigan Fair. There are over 350 4-H members auctioning off their market project at the 4-H Livestock Auction.

These members have been working hard for the past few months; raising their animals, attending club, county, or state meetings and events to learn more about their projects, keeping records, attending a clean-up work bee on the fairgrounds and marketing their projects to be sold. Once the Fair is done, the kids are not, as they must complete and submit a record book to the Livestock Council to show the profit or loss, how their experience was, and what they have learned.

**Buyer Pre-Registration** - Wednesday, August 10<sup>th</sup>, 5pm - 8pm – Many members will be in or near their animal pens eager to speak to you about their projects.

**Auction Day Buyer Registration** – Thursday, August 11<sup>th</sup>, starting at 8am.

**Upon arrival** – New Buyers check in at the New Buyer windows at the auction trailer. If you have recently purchased at our auction, please check in at the tent next to the trailer.

**At Check-In** – We will have you provide/verify your information, select your processor and receive your bid card.

**Resales** – Buyers can choose to donate the animal back as a resale or donate to Father Fred, Goodwill or Salvation Army; buyer is financially responsible to pay for the winning bid. Resale sheets will be posted after each Species in done at the auction.

**Payments & Check Out** – Payment is expected upon checkout or at the end of the auction. Invoicing is not available unless it is prearranged with Megan Town, Treasurer at 231-883-1004. Cash, check, and credit cards are accepted. There is a 3.5% fee added for credit card transactions. Interest fee will be applied after 45 days of sale upon no payment!
