PUBLIC COMMENT*

- Question from Kelly Stockfisch: did we figure in the postage increase that took place on January 22, 2023
 - Keri: We did not because the budget was proposed in November and was voted in on January 9, 2023, which was before the increase, we might need to come to membership and ask for additional funds.
 - Kelly: Have we thought about cleaning up the lists?
 - Keri: We did that two years ago, and Leslie has been working on it through the system.
- Question from Kelly Stockfisch: do we know how much the lunch will be at the Education Expo so people can be prepared since it is cashless?
 - Keri: The council board voted that we will pay for pizza and pop for the kids at lunch. Last year it cost us around \$300.00.
- Question from Kelly Stockfisch: do we know at this point, how much we have spent on the Expo?
 - Keri: Right now we have \$250.00 into the Expo, that was our deposit. A lot of our speakers come up for free, some of them require a hotel room. Some require speaking fees. Some

- require gas or mileage reimbursement. We are still working though that to see how much it is going to cost.
- Kelly: Are we opening the Expo up to other counties and will there be a cost to other counties?
 - Keri: We are not pushing it to other counties at this point. We don't really have a means to charge other counties to come in. Because this is what our kids' money is being used for, we want our kids to attend first. We are not saying if someone from Kalkaska show up, we are not pushing them away and not allowing them to come, but at this time we are not advertising it with other counties.
 - Kelly: How do other counties like Manistee open clinics up to us and charge us? I am just thinking of the cost of our kids' monies that pay for this and we are going to allow others from the outside to come in and how does that work.
 - Rosalie: That is going to be a hard thing, and right now how we are setting it up, it is done differently with our very skeletal system in 4H online which is the five counties that are welcome to come to our fair. Right now we don't have any clubs from Kalkaska, we have one club from Antrim, we have three from Benzie, and Leelanau has seven or eight pending, and Grand Traverse is the rest. We are just going to, as staff, solely advertise to our livestock people about the Expo. Also, staff will have control who is registering. Family members can pre register for courses which will help you save time at the event. We can print rosters for the sessions. If someone shows up at that point who is not a part of our system, we can ask them to sign up on 4H online, on scene, and check our forms and things like that. In terms of charging, I think we think about the different shows and events we have done that others have charged for, it might be a situation where they are just trying to break even. For us, we have a lot of money sitting in that account for the educational fund right now, so if we really look at who will attend that are not ours, how many guests from other counties did we have last year?
 - Keri: two
 - Rosalie: It was so minimal, and those that came, they were from Kalkaska and they needed help getting their education done before the fair, and it was a nice thing

- to do. But in terms of money spent, like overall, we really are trying to serve the needs of this audience.
- Kelly: I was just trying to do the checks and balances and how that worked and that information just hasn't really been out there, so I am just asking the questions.
- o Rosalie: we are pulling it together
- o Kelly: When is the registration opening?
- Rosalie: We have started it, but we have to get all of our sessions organized. I can't go any farther in that system and Emily is going to help me, and we will get it set up in there and then we have to work out any kind of issues with it. It shouldn't be an issue if we aren't collecting funding to go with it. We just have to get it in there. You go into your 4H Online account, and you can select the events button and it will automatically load for those five counties, anyone else, they won't see it.
- Kelly: Okay, thank you.
- Question from Unknown: Can I ask, along those lines, the lunch will be paid for, for the kid, what about parents that might be there? Will they need to pay?
 - Keri: Yes, it is cashless, you have to have a debit card or credit card of some sort.
 - Unknown: Do you need the parents to register, so you know how much food to have?
 - Keri: If the parents plan on attending any sessions, they need to register, so we can get their information, along with a room count. Because what is going to happen is if we have a session for sixty kids, and we have sixty five kids and ten parents, the parents will have to stand, so yes, parents will have to register.
 - Unknown: so this registration, Rosalie from 4H online.
 - Keri: Yes, this registration will be set up through 4H online
 - Rosalie: So parents can't unless you are a volunteer set up in the system. Parents are going to have to sign in on a roster sheet, and youth get first chair access. We are linking this with room capacity.
 - Keri: Any parents not on 4H online can just email the livestock council email and we can just add them to the list for a count.
- Question from Renee Hobbins: the education kits we got for sheep, goat, steer, swine, where are they?
 - Keri: those are housed at the MSU office
