EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS:

- DEADLINE FOR ALL REQUIREMENTS IS JUNE 30, 2019
- ALL 4-HERS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE 1 GENERAL SESSION AND 1 SPECIE SPECIFIC EDUCATION CREDIT IN ORDER TO QUALIFY TO BRING AN ANIMAL TO FAIR
- GENERAL SESSIONS WILL BE HELD AT 6PM ON THE MONDAY NIGHTS OF THE LIVESTOCK COUNCIL MEETINGS. REGULAR LIVESTOCK MEETINGS TO FOLLOW. THE EDUCATION SESSIONS WILL LAST 30-45 MINUTES. YOU MAY USE A SECOND SPECIE SPECIFIC EDUCATION SESSION TO COUNT TOWARDS A GENERAL SESSION
- SPECIE SPECIFIC EDUCATION SESSION DATES WILL BE AVAILABLE JANUARY 2019. 4-HERS MUST DO A SPECIE SPECIFIC EDUCATION REQUIREMENT FOR THEIR MARKET PROJECT.
- ANY EVENT SANCTIONED BY MSU IS AVAILABLE TO COUNT TOWARDS YOUR EDUCATION CREDITS, BUT YOU MUST GET A SIGNED EDUCATION SLIP AND RETURN IT TO THE LIVESTOCK COUNCIL FOR CREDIT.
- ANY NON-MSU SANCTIONED EVENT MUST HAVE PRIOR APPROVAL TO RECEIVE AN EDUCATION CREDIT.
