- Question from Jeff Dreves - Education expo, why the increase?
 - Keri Bancroft- We are adding technology to this year's Expo. Also, some of the species' chairs have requested that we get other speakers throughout the year for Fitting, Shearing and educational speakers for sessions. Kids can request to be reimbursed for shows and clinics.
 - Kristy Oosterhouse reminded those in attendance that we are an education first organization.
 - It was requested the how the break down from the Expo in 2024 was distributed.
 - 879 education credits given at \$6.05 per credit
 - 425 kids did 2 or more classes
 - \$12.53 per child was our cost that also included lunch for them.
 - Motion made by Jeff Dreves to keep the education fund budget at \$10,000.
 - 2nd by Josh Carpenter.
 - Majority vote Aye. Motion Carried.
 - Question from Kelly Stockfisch: Project Give Away, I thought these were to give away animals/ feed grants that were donated and why are we giving away more than we received?
 - Katrina had it listed under expenses instead of income. This has been corrected in the report.
 - Kelly Stockfisch: Then I'm asking why do we have it under this line item should this be moved then?
 - Board conferred with MSU.
 - Keri: The restricted income for the project was budgeted at \$5,000 which we were hoping to get.
 - Kelly: So why is it a line item?
 - Keri: It was moved because we got more donations. Technically this is the amount for the project giveaway.

12. Species Chair Updates

- Horse** – No update
- Dairy Beef** – Greg Bancroft
 - Dairy Feeder we had discussed the birth date could be born as early as December 1, 2024. Possession date will be March 3rd. Large Dairy Beef the registration is due January 20th. No number to report right now.
- Jr Beef** – Amanda Wilkins 231-357-0777 jrbeef4h@yahoo.com
 - Registrations are Due March 3rd. Also don't forget to sign up on the 4-H online as well!
 - Calves must be born after January 1st, so get on a breeder list now there is a list of breeders on Jr. Beef tab on the website. Possession date is May 15th. Reminder minimum weight of 300 lb and a maximum weight of 700lbs. Cloverbud and showmanship only can use smaller calves if they so desire. Don't forget to like the Facebook Pages as there is a lot of information posted on there, NWMI Livestock Council Beef Program and Northwest Michigan Livestock Council.
 - Education: MI Show ALL winter and spring
 - On the website there is an online option from Iowa state 4-H Animal Science Career Quest at MSU on February 15th the link to that registration is on the Facebook page. Education Expo 02/23.
- Large Beef** – Haven Bouwens
 - Registration due date extended to January 20th.
 - If you need to know who's on the list from your club get a hold of Haven. Working with the fair vet to stop the heifers from coming into heat during fair the plan has not been finalized. 2026 fair the possession date is moved to and the registration due date changed to November 2025. Required weigh in and at that time they can tag the steer projects for 2026.
 - Tagging will be delayed due to the registration delay, probably going into March. An extra-large Steer or heifer can be tagged for \$10 and can only be used within the family that purchased the animal. Text Haven the address where the animal is housed to help with tagging. MI show points are shared on the website. Winter beef there were 23 kids that earned education credits.
 - MSU AGR Beef Preview show, February 7-9th, MSU Pavilion Early Registration January 31. MSU Block & Bridle Show February 20-23.

 - Registration is due Feb 3rd all registration have to be in and are available on the swine tab.

- i. Make sure to get a hold of Lamb breeders.
 - ii. Virtual tagging again looking for the scrapies tag.
 - iii. Reposting the breeders list with number and livestock council page.
 - iv. Possible mandatory fitting. We will tag your lamb with a council tag at that time. In the by-laws the 4-Hers fit their lamb with help. Clippers and blades will be provided.
 - 1. Question from Elaine Taghon- if this is mandatory for the child will the child be disqualified if they can't attend?
 - 2. Clayton- We will come out and work with the kids on shearing, so we won't disqualify them.
 - v. The birth date has changed so the lambs can be born on or after December 1st. This was trying to help give more options.
 - vi. Discussion from membership asking for changes to be made a year in advance next time.
- g. **Rabbit/Cavy** – Notes that were sent to council from Lisa Ralph and read by Nicki Brown.
- i. If you are doing a single meat pen, the birth date must be February 3rd to February 10th. This would be a 6-month project - for the pen of three, or the single fryer which are 70 day projects, the rabbits must be born by May 24th. So that means they must be bred 30 days in advance which would take it to April 24th for breeding. Any questions on that project and let me (Lisa Ralph) know
 - ii. There are a few State shows coming up. There's one down at MSU. On January 25th. I'm sending along the link to the secretary so they can put that in the minutes. - be sure to have clean water. Lots of food, warm bedding for your animals right now. If you notice them. Starting to drop weight due to the temperatures and such. Make sure that you start putting a supplement in there either. Calf manna is what I use as well as sunflower seeds and oatmeal. This will help. Make sure they are out of drafts.

- i. Poultry Registration is open on the livestock council website. Please fill out a form for you market project and/or a form for your breed/show project. Possession date for production pullets is January 31st. Extreme weather when shipping will extend the date to February 8th. Production pullets must be a DUAL PURPOSE Breed. Hybrid or strictly egg layers will be disqualified. Read the guidelines for the project. Reminder: Always start poultry in a draft free area, plenty of water and the correct quality feed. Pine shavings or chips as bedding. Research and RED about your poultry project, from start to finish. Questions anytime, text Lynn at 231-357-5132 or email 4hchickenqueen@gmail.com. Please leave your name and name of the child, and which project they have chosen.

- **2025 Cattle Program Changes -Haven Bouwens, Greg Bancroft, Amanda Wilkins, Crystal Breithaupt, and Rick Tallieu**
 - Looking at changing the auction line up in the past we have looked from first to the last. We would like to move to a lotto system unless you place in the top 15. One reason for this is safety because there are a lot of cattle. Kudos to last year's judge. He did great remembering placings and helping fix. The past judges questioned placing first to last. This was the best solution we could find. As far as the buyers we could let them know and really buyers are there for an individual and the prices don't really show they are looking at the line up for quality. In the past we have 8 weight classes or so the deepest we went there were 4 consistently more discussions regarding this. Top 3 from each weight class and wash rack as needed and replaced as needed until he runs out.
 - Ella Stockfish commented about late shows and safety in the past and it's not safe.
 - Question from Jeff Dreves: if we get a crazy high amount or a low amount will this process change?

- Haven: We at least have to go 1-15 per the premium book for this year but we can revisit this in the future.

- Question from Sarah Youker: So you are going to take 3 from each class and you are going to fill in those spaces. How deep?
 - Haven: In the past we only ever went 4-6.

 - Haven: We will take it into consideration.

 - Haven: The overall beef will go first no matter whether heifer or steer.
