

2021 Project Giveaway

1. To be eligible, participants must:
 - a. Have been registered with the 4-H Livestock Council for a 2020 project, regardless of virtual participation.
 - b. Be currently registered with MSU through the 4HOnline system.
 - c. Be at least 8 years of age by 1/1/2021.
 - d. Complete the online 2021 Project Give-Away registration no later than October 25th.
 - i. Enter at: <https://forms.gle/xtq2RRSTG7UnppZRA>
 - ii. You will be asked to provide a short written explanation OR a video including the following information:
 1. Your 4-H experience thus far
 2. Why you want to raise this project animal for 2021
 3. What resources you have to raise and care for this project animal
 - iii. Participants will only be allowed to enter 1 Giveaway.
2. Awarding the 2021 Project Vouchers:
 - a. Participants must be signed into the November 2nd Livestock Council meeting (by video or phone).
 - b. The wheel will be spun during meeting.
 - i. Names of all registered participants that meet the eligibility requirements will be entered alphabetically into a list on wheelofnames.com.
 - ii. The names will then be shuffled 3 times.
 - iii. The wheel will be clicked to "spin".
 - iv. The participant whose name is indicated by the arrow when the wheel stops will be the winner.
 - v. If the winning participant is not signed into the meeting, the wheel will be spun again until a winner can be awarded.
 - c. All names of eligible participants that were present at the meeting will be retained. If at any point the winning participant is unwilling or unable to care for the animal awarded to them, an alternate will be selected by spinning a new wheel.
3. All winners agree to the following:
 - a. To show the animal in the appropriate 4-H Livestock Council show the following year, whether virtual or in-person.
 - b. To market and sell the animal via the 4-H Livestock Council and/or the Northwestern Michigan Fair the following year.
 - c. To allow the 4-H Livestock Council executive board members and/or the appropriate species chair the ability to inspect the animal throughout the year.
 - d. If at any time, the 4-H Livestock Council Board feels that the animal is not being properly cared for, it has the right and responsibility to remove the animal from the participants care.
 - e. If an animal is removed from the winning participant's care prior to the species specific possession date, it will be offered to the alternate. No expenses will be reimbursed to the original winner.
 - f. If an animal is removed from the winning participant's care after the species specific possession date, it will become the property of the Northwest Michigan 4-H Livestock Council. It will be cared for by the council to be marketed and sold as originally intended. Proceeds from that sale will be used to sponsor future project giveaways.
